PREPARING COLPECH'S YOUTH FOR THE 2026 EDITION OF "LO MEJOR DEL CAFÉ"

With the firm purpose of fostering community pride and a strong sense of belonging, in July we launched the preparatory activities for the 2026-2027 edition of **"Lo Mejor del Café"**, a project that highlights the positive aspects of the coffee world and its positive impact on the community.

We began with the first two training workshops for young people from the community of Colpech, home to our third **Coffee Club**.

These sessions focused on learning storytelling and documentation techniques, providing students with practical tools to capture the lives, efforts, and achievements of the people in their community.

The main goal is for the young people themselves to research, document, and present the positive impact of coffee farming in the 2027 edition, strengthening leadership and a sense of belonging throughout the community.





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EXPANDING HYDROPONICS: MULTIPLYING FOOD SECURITY

The Hydroponics Project continues to demonstrate its potential as a real driver of change in the nutrition and economic well-being of families.

During July, we significantly expanded its reach by training 97 new participants in the communities of Tuipic, Cerro Gavilán, and La Vega in Huehuetenango.

This initiative is the result of a strategic partnership with the **AVANZA Project**, allowing us to scale our impact toward the goal of benefiting more than 250 additional women and their families

This achievement complements our ongoing commitment to our donor **Tchibo**, multiplying opportunities for food security and agricultural entrepreneurship in the region.
